

## FLORIDA'S A-F GRADING SYSTEM: AN OVERVIEW

Since 1999, Florida has graded its schools on an A-F grading scale. School grades help us understand how well each school is serving its students. There are 11 grading components under 4 main categories.

Grade	Student Scale	School Scale
A	90% and up	62% and up
B	80% - 89%	54% - 61%
C	70% - 79%	41% - 53%
D	60% - 69%	32% - 40%
F	59% or lower	31% or lower

### A Achievement

- % of students who pass statewide FSA in:  
Reading  
Math
- % of students who pass test in:  
Science  
Social Studies

### L Learning

- # of students improved test scores:  
Reading  
Math
- For the 25% of students who scored the lowest, improvement in test scores in:  
Reading  
Math

### A Acceleration

- # of middle school students who pass a high school level test
- # high school students who pass a college level test or class

### R Readiness

- % of students graduating High School
